

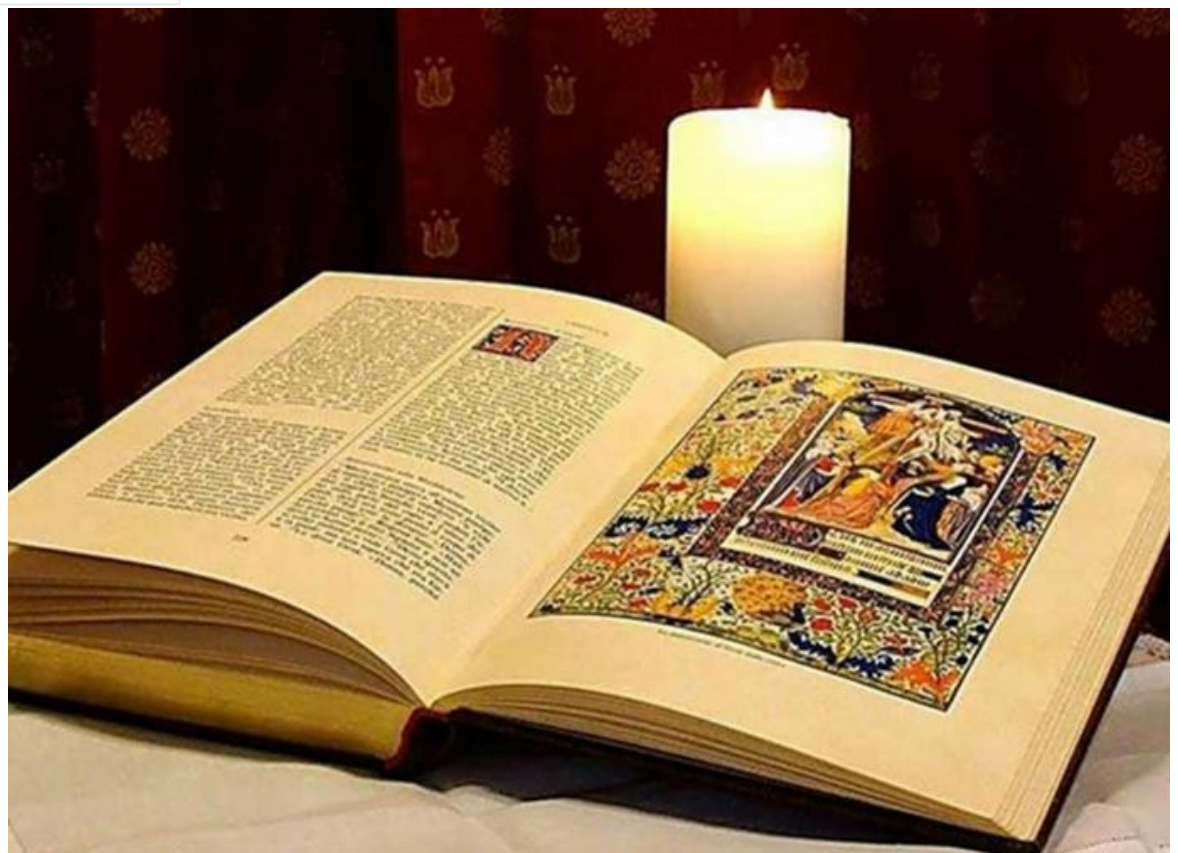

*Jesus said to his disciples: "But to what shall I compare this generation?
