Looking at his disciples, he said: "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God. Blessed are you who hunger now, for you will be satisfied. Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh. Blessed are you when people hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man. "Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, because great is your reward in heaven. For that is how their ancestors treated the prophets. Sometimes these people are currently unable even to understand what is revealed to them. To be disciples and spread the message of His teaching, it is therefore necessary to be humble enough to follow Jesus instead of our weak and unstable will. Let us strive to cultivate more our spiritual humility than our will and desires for material goods.
